Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame:

The Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame was established in 2014 to honour the legends and heroes of South Australian motorcycling and highlight their achievements and contributions to the sport.

Each year a Hall of Fame ceremony will take place to honour the elite group of new inductees. The Hall of Fame ceremony will be held at the Motorcycling SA Night of Champions, in late November each year, and will be open to the whole association & public to attend.

The purpose of this selection procedure is to set a clear criteria outline and requirements for applications of nominations for inductees to the Hall of Fame. Below is an overview of the process of selection for the Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame:



Nomination

A nomination of an individual to the Hall of Fame may be submitted by anyone, even the association (MSA). The individual that is nominated must meet the selection criteria as listed below. Use of the Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame application form is required and the complete form must be received no later than the cut-off date, for this individual to be considered in the annual induction cycle. The nominee must provide acceptance of the nomination.

Review/Eligibility

Motorcycling SA staff will review the application of the nominee on behalf of the MSA Hall of Fame selection committee. This review will consider credentials and background to confirm eligibility. Once finalised Motorcycling SA will refer eligible nominees to the selection committee for further consideration.

Important Note:

- Nominee or family link must accept their nomination before any further selection process is undertaken

Selection

The MSA Hall of Fame selection committee will review the application submitted, validate credentials, fact-check and perform necessary due diligence for each assigned applicant. Motorcycling SA and other parties may be asked for additional information. Once the Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame selection committee has reviewed all applicants and have selected its recommended nominees, they are provided to the Motorcycling SA Board for the final decision for the years inductees.

Induction

Inductees will be honoured at the annual induction ceremony on the Night of Champions held annually and will be welcomed in to the prestigious ranks of the Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame.

Motorcycling SA will work with the inductees and/or their families to ensure they are appropriately recognised, and able to attend the award presentation.

Motorcycling SA Hall Of Fame Selection Committee Structure:

The Motorcycling SA Hall of fame Selection Committee is made a Board appointed committee of people from Motorcycling SA's members and an independent delegate from outside the sport. The Committee may also have a Motorcycling SA Board member sit in on these committee meetings.

MSA Hall of Fame Committee will review any prior year nominations (not inducted) and any new application packages. Once all applications are received the committee will then meet at one or more meetings to discuss/ complete the following:

- i) If the applicant is not suitable for nomination
- ii) Conduct additional research, fact – checking and due diligence activities: and document the applicant's background and accomplishments
- iii) Determine which applications, if any, to recommend for induction
- iv) Final recommendation to the Motorcycling SA Board

Application:

An application for Nomination to the Hall Of Fame may be submitted by anyone within the community. Applications may be submitted on one's own behalf or that of another. The Motorcycling SA Hall of Fame application form must be used: Application forms can be found on the Motorcycling SA website: [LINK](#)

The application form should be addressed as provided, and the completed form must be received no later than the cut-off date of any given year for the individual to be considered in the next annual Hall of Fame induction cycle. The proposed individual must meet the base eligibility requirements as provided in this criteria outline below.

Eligibility:

Competitor:

- A. Eligibility for competition applicants in any discipline (Enduro, Dirt Track/ Track, Motocross, Supercross, road race, speedway, reliability trials & Moto Trials)
 - i) Competition Applicants must be retired from active participation for at least two (2) years. This means for at least two years the rider must not have compete in:
 - (1) National/ International Level Competition seeking highest expert honours
 - (2) State Championship events/Series in Pro/Open classes
 - ii) The two (2) – year period shall commence on the January 1 after the year in which such applicant has last competed as outlined above; and shall be fulfilled on December 31 of the second year.

General Member:

- B. Direct Service to the sport: Administrator, Coaching & Officiating, Team Manager, Clubs, Promoter, Crew, Chief Engineers

How are the nominees considered as South Australians? (Does not need to include all)

- Have held an A.C.U SA or MA/MSA Licence
- Born in SA
- Have resided in SA
- Achieved most of Prominence of achievement as a SA licence holder/resident

Removal from the Hall of Fame:

The Motorcycling SA Board retains, at its sole discretion, the authority to rescind membership of the Hall of Fame should an individual act in a manner, or be involved in activities that may bring the sport, Motorcycling SA and/or the Hall of Fame into disrepute.

Examples may include:

- Anti doping breaches
- Conviction of criminal offences
- Significant and/or persistent behavioural breaches of the Code of Conduct

Hall Of Fame membership entitles the individual to:

- Recognition Listing on the MSA Website, Hall of Fame section
- Recognition at the MSA Head Office in Beulah Park with a display in our Hall of Fame
- Two (2) free tickets to the annual Night of Champions
