



2018 SAORC – Club- Expression of Interest to Host a Round

To the Club and its Members,

The South Australian Off Road Championship (SAORC) is currently seeking expressions of interest from South Australian clubs to host rounds in 2018.

The SAORC Series has developed into one of high quality and growing in numbers and professionalism. To keep this tradition going the SAORC Sports Manager Owen Rothe and his Exec are looking for clubs to run one round on a Sunday or two rounds on a Saturday & Sunday in **2018**.

Specifically Motorcycling SA is seeking your clubs interest in hosting a round, but also how it may fit in your clubs plans, as well as the SAORC program for 2018. Weather dictates that we are generally limited to the period March to October, with property availability to clubs a major factor.

If you chose to run a round it would help the selection process to know what area and what months suits your club.

Please inform us of the months that would be unavailable to your club as well. This is because if there is a clash of months between clubs we can work together on this matter.

Also in order of preference your choice of discipline being - Enduro, Sprint or Cross Country.

Enquiries have been made separately for the hosting of AORC/SAORC round. If you have an interest, please make sure this is registered with Owen.

The procedure of these events in regards to timing, official website, trophies & official photographer, ambulance and the supplementary regulations at these events are organized by the Sports Manager, exec and committee. It is hoped to have this resolved as soon as possible, and no later than mid-November.

A few essential aspects to consider whether to apply for a SAORC round:

Club and its members must provide commitment to deliver the event, including compliance with Motorcycling SA requirements.

Clubs must work collaboratively with Motorcycling SA, Enduro Sports Manager (and Committee) and designate Key Officials on the preparation and smooth running of the event.

Have one key contact for race day for track and related issues. Ensure tracks are suitably developed and marked, in accordance with the expectations and requirements of Motorcycling SA/SAORC Committee.
