Last weekend saw him claiming another race win on Saturday in the mud feast cross-country, he then backed it on Sunday with a strong fourth finish in the sprint format.

“Saturday was so muddy and I had no goggles after half a lap due to them filling up with mud and water. I wasn’t alone, we all had to deal with it, so I just put my head down and went for it”.

Another stand out for Ahola was finishing Saturday’s cross-country in 10th position outright, proving he has the pace to mix it with the more experienced big names like Price, Merriman and Grabham.

Ahola added “Sunday was tough as my eyes where pretty sore from all the mud in them after Saturday. I did what I could to maintain my overall lead”.

The next round will take place on 7th & 8th of August in Rhyce’s home state of South Australia. He’ll be aiming for more big results, especially being on his home soil and literally in his own backyard.
