MSA Information

Medical Standards

MSA has been working to define the necessary Medical Standards that are required to be met for all disciplines for permitted events.

Attached to this newsletter, I provide a draft of a document aimed at achieving this. It should be noted that this is a draft that remains the subject of ongoing discussions with St John and other medical service providers. It has been developed with consideration for the risk of various disciplines, and the ability for clubs to meet these requirements. Thanks must go to Bob Christie, Chief Medical Officer at Mallala, and Jenni Bichard, from Gillman Speedway for their input and comments.

Clubs are invited to provide comment on the draft. Feedback can be provided either through discipline Sports Managers or directly to me. Specifically I would appreciate feedback on:

- The level of service allocated to each discipline, with consideration for practice/club and interclub meetings;
- Appropriateness of qualification required for each level;
- Appropriateness of equipment requirements for each level; and
- Ability for clubs to comply.

Obviously the safety of our riders, officials and spectators is important, so we need to achieve a balance on what is needed and what is practical.

Any comments would be appreciated by 31 January 2012.
