Guidelines for Obtaining or Renewing a Level 1 Coaching Licence

Motorcycling Australia (MA) Coaches are recognised by National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS).

MA Coaching Accreditation and the MA Coaching Licence is valid for a period of 4 years at which time both the accreditation and Licence must be renewed.

To obtain a Level 1 Coaching Licence and accreditation you must:

- ❖ *You must be 18 years of age to obtain a Level 1 Coaching Licence and accreditation.*
- ❖ Obtain a South Australian Police Clearance
- ❖ Enter and Attend a MSA Level 1 Coaching Course
- ❖ Complete a Level 1 Coaching Licence Application Form
- ❖ Complete the Level 1 Coaching Course General Principles
- ❖ Undertake 30 hours of motorcycle coaching activity under an accredited Level 1 or Level 2 Coach at MSA Permitted Coaching days, these hours must be logged

To maintain a Level 1 Coaching Licence and accreditation you must:

- ❖ Complete a minimum of 20 hours of sport specific tasks and a maximum of 10 hours of general sports tasks within the 4 year term of the Level 1 Coaching Licence and accreditation
- ❖ Supply a South Australian Police Clearance Certificate to MSA at the time of renewal
- ❖ Complete a Level 1 Coaching Licence Application Form and supply a copy of the Log Book of Hours and return to MSA

Examples of Sport Specific Tasks are:

- ❖ Attend and assist at MSA coaching days
- ❖ Attend and assist at MSA affiliated club permitted coaching days
- ❖ Attend organised motorcycling training camps

Examples of General Sport Tasks are:

- ❖ Attend NCAS/ORS up to date courses
- ❖ Obtain Sport Trainer accreditation
- ❖ Obtain a certificate in First Aid Attend with either St John or the Red Cross

Note: Your Application follows an MSA procedure and may or may not be issued at the discretion of MSA
