1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the 2010 Alice Springs Masters Games Natural Terrain Scrambles for all Masters Classes at the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, on Thursday 14 October 2010.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motor Cycling Australia Northern Territory (MANT) which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number 050/10 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Licences where the participants are 30 years of age or older..
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MANT.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail 1st OCTOBER 2010.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club, if such retention is approved by MANT.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE [CLUB OR PROMOTER - WHICHEVER IS APPLICABLE].**

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

St John Ambulance will be in attendance.

6 CLASSES OF COMPETITION

0 – 250cc 2 Stroke and 4 Stroke:

- Class 1 – 30 – 34 Years
- Class 3 – 35 – 39 years
- Class 5 – 40 – 49 Years
- Class 7 – 50 – 59 Years
- Class 9 – 60 Years of age and over may ride bikes of any capacity 2 stroke or 4 Stroke.
- Class 10 – 30 -45 Years Quads
- Class 11 – 46 years & over Quads

251+ cc 2 Stroke and 4 Stroke:

- Class 2 – 30 – 34 Years
- Class 4 - 35 – 39 Years
- Class 6 – 40 – 49 Years
- Class 8 - 50 -59 Years

7 AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Gold, Silver and Bronze Alice Springs Masters Games Medals will be awarded to each Class in each age group.

8 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

8.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be 3 riders. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club], subject to MANT approval.

9 RACE FORMAT:

There will be 2 laps of practice for each class. Depending on numbers classes will be combined. Order of racing will be in order from Oldest to youngest. There will be 3 rounds of 6 laps for each event. The track will be completed in a clockwise direction.

There is provision for an all powers race at the end of the racing that will consist of one race of 6 Laps in an anticlockwise direction.

10 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

10.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Motocross competition.

10.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

11. HANDICAP & SCORING

The Handicap will be one point per year of age above the minimum age of your class age group per the entry form. The position points earned in the three rounds will be added together, then your Age Handicap will be added to determine outright age group finishing positions. Finish position and position points in each round will be scored per GCR 5.8.9.

12 RIDING NUMBERS:

12.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the [Club's or Promoter's - whichever is applicable] discretion.

13 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. Details will be included in the final instructions.

14 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.

14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the medal award may be delayed at the MANTJ discretion until the results of the tests are known. For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 07.30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

15 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors and officials are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

17 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

The starting gates consist of 22 steel drop gates on a dirt surface. The track consists of 1.6km of undulating ground with creek crossings and varying dirt surfaces. The track is watered for dust control

18 RACING:

There will be 2 practice laps for each class. The event will be determined by 3 rounds of racing. At the completion of the event an all powers race will be conducted for bragging rights. Racing order will be determined on the day.

19 NOISE:

GCR 12.10.1.1 noise emissions must not exceed 96 Db (a) unless a lower limit is provided for in S.R. or in a discipline specific chapter of these rules.

20 LICENCES

Rally class riders may obtain a 1 day Event licence at the cost \$45.00. A special One Event National Licence is also available at the cost of \$88.00 for riders to compete for the entire 3 events.

21 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 21.1 Entry to the track is free. Full canteen and bar facilities are available. **BYO alcohol is not allowed.**
- 21.2 Motorbikes will not be ridden in the pit area.
- 21.3 Alcohol is not permitted in the pit area.
- 21.4 All riders will enter/exit the track at the chute located adjacent to the shaded pit area.
- 21.5 Riders may compact or remove dirt in the ruts at the start line. The repair will not extend past a bike length either side of the start gates.
- 21.6 All riders must provide a person to conduct duties at the track on race day.
- 21.7 Flag officials will be rostered. Any rider who doesn't provide an official may be removed from the start line and not participate until they are duly represented.
- 21.8 Yellow Flags may be displayed in two ways. A failure to comply with conditions of the yellow flag will on the first occasion cause, the rider to be relegated 3 places and on subsequent offences excluded from the race:
 - 21.8.1 Yellow Flag held stationary – danger, drive slowly overtaking is forbidden.
 - 21.8.2 Yellow Flag waved – immediate danger, slow down and prepare to stop, overtaking is forbidden.
- 21.9 Presentation will be held at the Alice Springs Motorcycle Club.

CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN MOTORCYCLE SPORTING EVENT AND/OR ACTIVITY

1. I (block letters) _____ (RIDER)

HEREBY AGREE with the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1 (hereinafter collectively called "the organisers") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the meeting") at the venue listed in Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS AND OBLIGATIONS

2. **I ACKNOWLEDGE** that the sport of motorcycle racing is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport and participating in the race meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:

- a) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- b) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- c) that other competitors may ride dangerously or with lack of skill;
- d) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
 - e) that the organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agent or representatives of those in charge of race meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time and/or events;
- f) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be avoided;
- g) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
- h) that I have an obligation to myself and others to compete safely and within the rules of competition.

INDEMNITY GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

3. **IN CONSIDERATION** of the acceptance of me as an entrant in the meeting **I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY** the organisers and each of them in the following manner:

- a) that I participate in the race meeting at my sole risk and responsibly;
- b) that I accept the venue as it stands with all or any defect hidden or exposed;
- c) that I indemnify and hold harmless the organisers, their respective servants, agents or officials against any actions or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf or by other parties for or in respect of or rising out of my death or any injury, loss or damage caused to me or to my machine or equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any manner whatsoever.
