1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Mount Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc. hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct interclub road racing at McNamara Park, on 6th, 7th & 8th April, 2012

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C12000 and is open to holders of current financial members of Mount Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc., Atujara MCC, Cafe Racer, Phoenix (Including those taking out a 5 day membership as laid out in the Mount Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club's Constitution.). All riders and sidecar passengers must be **either** holders of a current M.A. National or Club Road Race licence **or** must take out a one-event licence for the meeting. Riders in the latter category must have previous road race experience or have passed a licence testing application prior to the meeting (this can be organised by contacting the MGMC&LC Clubs Coach on 08 8767 2839 or 0428 854 329 or by contacting a Club near you). Application for a one-event license must be made simultaneously with submission of entry form and issue of the licence is conditional upon the rider competing in only those events and on those machines as specified in the entry form. The issue of one-event licences will be at the discretion of the Secretary of Meeting, with right of appeal to the Steward as per GCR's. 14 year old competitors with Junior Licences endorsed for Road Racing in the 125ccGP Class are also eligible to enter. The race meeting will also be open to Junior riders 9 to under 12, 70cc Manual and 12-under 16 years of age with solo machines 80cc 2stroke and 160cc 4 stroke & have completed compulsory 5 hours coaching.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and **close last mail Thursday 8th March 2012**. Send entries to the Race Secretary at the above address or scan and Email to racesec@macpark.org or fax to 08 87 673150.
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Mt Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES AND ENTRIES WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CLUB.**

4. **INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

A SA Ambulance or Paramedics will be in attendance at all times during practice and racing on Friday 6th, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th April 2012.

6 **ENTRY FEE:**

- 6.1. Senior Entry Fee (inc. Mandatory MSA rider levy) – \$150.
Additional Class or extra bike/s (not including spare bike) Entry Fee - \$75
Sidecar Entry Fee (inc 2 x Mandatory MSA rider ley) - \$160
Junior Entry Fee (inc. Mandatory MSA rider levy) - \$105.
One-Event Licence - \$45.
5 Day Membership – Included in Entry Fee
Note: All entry fees include \$20 cost of transponder + all additional bikes will incur an extra \$20 transponder fee per bike.
- 6.2. **Payment Methods:** Direct Deposit to **Mount Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc, Commonwealth Bank, BSB 065 504, Account 00420116** (Please include copy of stamped deposit slip or receipt with your entry), or by personal cheque, bank cheque, money order to the above address or cash in person at one of our Track Days on the last Saturday of every month or during a committee meeting on the second Tuesday of every month.
ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.
- 6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Mount Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc. (MGMC&LCC Inc.)
- 6.4. **Please Note:** Acceptance Form & passes will not be sent out to you. Event & Rider listings will be posted on our website at www.macpak.org after entries close. If you cannot get access to the internet, phone 08 87672839 for confirmation. Passes can be collected from the Scrutineering Shed when you sign in.

7 **ENTRY PASSES:**

Each Solo Rider entered shall receive 2 passes for each day.
Each Sidecar Rider entered shall receive 3 passes for each day.
Participants quoting a current Entrants Licence shall receive 1 extra pass for each day.
Additional passes may be ordered on the entry form.
No passes required for Friday practice/qualifying.

8 **CLASSES OF COMPETITION**

MRRDA -

Nippers - Up to 70cc machines as per 2012 MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 9yrs to under 12 yrs
Junior 2 - Up to 85cc 2 stroke machines as per 2012MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 12yrs to under 16yrs.
Junior 4 - Up to 160cc 4 stroke machines as per 2012 MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 12 yrs to under 16 yrs.
125 Grand Prix - 125 Grand Prix machines as per 2012 MA GCR's. 14 yrs and above May be run with Formula Mac Park.
250 Mono - 250 Four Stroke, Single Cylinder machines as per 2012 MA GCR's. 14 yrs and above May be run with Formula Mac Park.
Over 600cc - 4 stroke over 600 cc 4-cyl, over 675cc 3-cyl & over 750cc 2-cyl machines complying with GCRs 15.1-15.5. Tyre choice open.
600cc - 4 stroke 600cc 4-cyl, 675cc 3-cyl & 750cc 2-cyl machines complying with GCRs. Tyre choice open.
20th Century - Machines designated plated 1999 model or earlier incorporating motorcycles eligible for Period 6 as per GCR's.
Formula Mac Park - 2 Stroke and 4 Stroke multi-cylinder machines up to 400cc are eligible, twin cylinder machines to 650cc (to 750cc 2 valve only) and single cylinder machines up to 800cc. 125ccGP Junior and Senior are also included in this class. Riders of 250cc GP and 250cc Production machines are encouraged to participate.
Historic Group 1 – consisting of Period 3, Combined 125cc & Superlights.
Historic Group 2 – consisting of Period 4 & 5.
Sidecars-Open to all sidecars
FEATURE RACES: The Club will conduct the following feature races:
The 50th Anniversary Easter Cup of 50kms - Open to invited A, B & selected C grade riders on machines of 600cc and above at the discretion of the Club. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Friday.
Consolation 50th Anniversary Easter Cup of 50kms - Open to C & D grade riders and those not selected for Easter Cup at the discretion of the Club. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Friday.
The Laurie Fox Classic 50th Anniversary Easter Cup of 20kms - Open to Period 3 machines. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Friday.
The Post Classic/Forgotten Era 50th Anniversary Easter Cup of 20kms - Open to Period 4 and 5 machines. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Friday.
Sidecar 50th Anniversary Easter Cup of 20kms- Open to sidecars

9 AWARDS

(See table at end of Sup Regs.)

Awards - First overall point scorers will receive a Free Entry Voucher valid for 12 months unless indicated otherwise and according to the following numbers of competitors:- Races of where there is one entrant only in a class, no award will be awarded.

Trophies - Second and third overall points scorers receive trophies unless indicated otherwise and according to the following numbers of competitors:- Races of where there is one entrant only in a class, no award/trophy will be awarded, 2 to 3 competitors - first only; Races of 4 to 6 competitors - first and second, Races of 7 or more competitors – first, second and third. Number of award/trophies per class will be based on numbers at official close of entries.

No late entries after official program is printed.

Period of Holding Awards – Awards to be picked up at the Presentation Ceremony following the race meeting. If you are unable to attend the ceremony please nominate someone to collect for you. Awards/Trophies will not be held.

10 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards will be at the discretion of the club, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

11 RACE FORMAT:

- 11.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for Road Race competition. Attention is drawn to the following points.
- 11.2 All modern machines front brake calliper bolts to be lockwired in the tightened position as per GCR's.
- 11.3 All modern, Period 4, 5 & 6 machines must have engine end case protectors fitted as per GCR's.
- 11.4 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 11.5 Change of machine by permission of Clerk of Course, original allocated number to be fitted.
- 11.6 Spare machines MUST be entered and scrutineered at official scrutineering.
- 11.7 Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding numbers or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion.
- 11.8 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with GCR's.

12 GRID POSITIONS:

- 12.1 For all classes starting positions will be determined by 2 timed Qualifying Sessions on Friday 6th April from 1pm. Combined classes in feature races may get an extra qualifying session if deemed necessary by the club. If unable to qualify starting position for races on Saturday and Sunday will be at rear of grid.

13 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. All riders MUST sign in at Riders Brief to be held on Friday 6th April

14 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

15 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

16 TIMETABLE:

Friday 6th April - Scrutineering from 7:30am to 12noon. Practice from 9am to 12 noon. Riders Briefing at 12:45pm. Qualifying from 1pm
Saturday- Limited practice from 9am with racing to follow.
Sunday – Limited practice from 9am with racing to follow.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be **7:30am** with the completion of the meeting for the participant being a half hour after their last event.

17 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Races will be conducted on a sealed course of 2.4 Km in a clockwise direction.

18 STARTS:

All races will be clutch start. Starting will be by lights; RED - for prepare to start, RED light off - for start. An amber light will flash if a start is aborted.

19 RACING:

All heats, races and laps for all Classes as laid out in "Awards" table at the end of Sup Regs.

20 NOISE:

As Per GCR's

21 GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

22 SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 24.1 Pit Enclosure – The pit enclosure is a dead engine area, except the bitumised entry & exit roads.
- 24.2 **NO BURNOUTS- PENALTIES APPLY STARTING AT \$500 at the discretion of the Club**
- 24.2 Scrutineering – All riders must wear racing apparel, All machines with fairings must have the belly pan removed and all old scrutineering stickers must be removed.
- 24.3 Garages – A limited number of powered garages available in the pit area at \$70 per bay for the weekend. One bay per entry.(Comfortably fits 2 bikes) New sheds 37-42 are available at \$130 per bay for the weekend. Only one bay per entry. (Comfortably fits 4 bikes) Bookings will only be accepted on receipt of Entry form when accompanied by full payment
- 24.4 All Historic machines must have log books presented at machine examining or no start. As per GCR's.
- 24.5 **Timing:** Timing will be electronic and EACH machine will be allocated a transponder; the hire charges are included in the entry fee. Riders will be responsible for the safe return of their transponders and a fee will be charged for loss or damage. Before transponders are handed over, competitors will need to provide security to the hirer at the track. Those who hold a MA National Licence will need to hand over their licences. Those who are competing under a One Event Licence will be required to provide a \$50 deposit for each transponder. The security will be handed back when the transponders are returned in good order to the hirer.
- 24.6 Camping – Bushland style camping is available for a fee of \$10 per person per day. Under 16 free. Camping can commence 4pm Wednesday 3rd April till 10am Monday 9th April
- 24.7 **NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA AS PER GCR'S.**
- 24.8 **NO ANIMALS PERMITTED WITHIN THE CIRCUIT BOUNDARY AS PER GCR'S.**
- 24.9 **UNATTENDED CHILDREN ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THEIR PARENTS.**

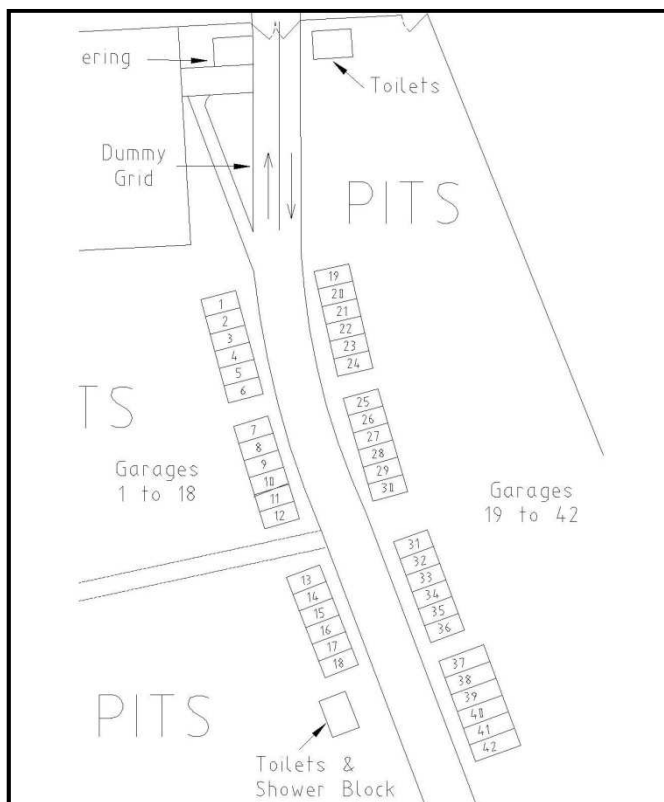
