Local rider Steph Cutler takes home the prize at the first S.A. Womens State Motocross Championship.

Local riders dominated the first South Australian Womens Motocross Gold Cup held on July 4th at Murray Bridge MX Track at Monarto SA. The track was in top condition after rain Friday night and riders were treated to perfect weather on the day. A round of the Clubman State Series completed the days racing.

The date clash with the Hattah Desert Race meant resulted in a smaller field than anticipated for the Womens Gold Cup as potential competitors were forced to pick between events but competition was fast and furious as the riders fought it out to determine who would take home the \$1000 purse.

After the days racing it was Steph Cutler of Port Augusta who walked away with the winners' cheque. Steph was dominant on the day winning all four races onboard her Kawasaki KX250. An ecstatic Steph commented "MSA deserves a massive pat on the back for this event. It's awesome to see girls race for such a lucrative prize. I'll be back next year for sure and I know as the word gets out this event will only get bigger."

MA Womens Commissioner Lyn Long attended the inaugural event and is convinced the Womens Gold Cup is destined to become a mainstay for riders seeking high calibre events to participate in. "I'm thrilled to see state bodies promoting the growth of women's racing, its a very positive step towards building a substantial women's race calendar. Being part of the growth of Womens racing is a boon for any potential sponsor- it's an untapped opportunity and the girls definitely have a lot to offer. The depth of talent in Womens motocross can only increase with events like this on offer."
