2012 SOUTH AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

ONE WEEK AFTER THE AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA!

The 2012 South Australian Championships will be run by the Juventus MCC and will be held at their property at Rockleigh, which is near the Adelaide Hills town of Mount Torrens.

Early news on the 2012 South Australian Championships is that it will revert to the traditional gate at the Rockleigh property, which will take riders to the back of the paddock, home of the 'sand pit'! Camping will be allowed on site, and there is plenty of room, which will continue the great trend started by the AJS MTC over the last two years at the Hogan's property, Mungeree, and the event will also be fully catered by the Juventus catering crew.

As has been the case for the last few years, the South Australian Championships will be 2 all day rides for all competitors, so there will be a need for observers, so if you aren't riding and can help out, even if just for 1 day, please let the Juventus Club know as soon as possible.

TROY Series SA 2012

2012 sees TROY Series SA, now heading into its 3rd year, continue to grow, not only in numbers, but also in stature in South Australia. It is hoped that the record numbers at all 2011 rounds will fall by the wayside as more and more riders take up moto trials here in SA in 2012.

For the first time, and for the next 3 years, TROY Series SA now has a naming rights, or major, sponsor, with Greg Knight and his team from Sherco Moto SA, backed by the Moto Central Group in Canberra, coming onboard to sponsor the series. So, from 2012, the series will be known as **SHERCO MOTO TROY Series SA!**

TROY, or **T**rials **R**ider **O**f the **Y**ear, will remain a 4 round series in 2012, with each of our moto trials clubs running a round, starting with the season opener at Victor Harbour on March 25th, and ending at Tungkillo on July 29th. ALL rounds will count towards the series, with series points allocated to riders as per the MoMS; 1st = 25 points down to 15th = 1 point. All 7 classes will once again be run; RED (Expert & A Grade), YELLOW (B Grade), BLUE (C Grade), WHITE (Junior A & B), BLACK & WHITE (Post Classic & Clubman), PINK (Senior & Junior Women) and RED & WHITE (A Grade & B Grade/Classic Sidecar).

Riders riding in the new 'Non Comp' Class, and those on Rec Licences are also more than welcome to ride each round, but as stipulated in the rules, will not be eligible for series points.

Rounds will be as follows;

All Clubs have been asked to consider that to add to the growing stature of the series, all rounds be a full day ride, for all grades in 2012, and that catering also be provided, as the series will also be heavily promoted within the whole of motorcycling in South Australia. Check the supp regs when entering for confirmation of these details.

Rounds 2, 3 & 4 also have JDP Training Camps being held on the Saturday before, so camping options should also be available for all those who are planning on attending both. At this stage it is unknown if camping will be permitted at Victor Harbour - also read the supp regs carefully for confirmation, but there are many options for overnight camping in Victor Harbour as well!

The popular Captain's Flat property, located on the Captain's Flat Road, between Captains Flat and Canberra, and kindly provided by Russell Beckett, will again be the venue. Temperature in the Blue Mountains should be a little friendlier for any South Australian competitors than it would be in July.

They are circulating this event information quite a bit earlier than usual in order to give riders, and their families, plenty of time to book accommodation and to make travel arrangements. www.captainsflat.org will be able to help with some accommodation options for all those heading over.

Bev Anderson-Tranter and Trevor Bennett were impressed with the way the Taste Eden Valley South Australian Women's Cup was set up during Trials Week 2011. With that in mind they intend to run all of the Women's Classes in separate sections at the 2012 Sherco Australian Womens Cup, and then all other 'blokes' classes as support classes.

Of course, to make this format successful they are seeking the support of women Trials riders from right across Australia, so put this on your calendar today, and lets have a huge SA presence in the ACT at Easter. It's at the start of the SA school holidays, so zoom over and then take your time coming home!

MOTO TRIALS SA JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

In what is exciting news for moto trials in South Australia, and our future stars in the sport, **Moto Trials SA**, in conjunction with **Motorcycling SA** and supported by **The Hell Team** and **Gas Gas Motos Australia**, are proud to announce the forming of a '**Junior Development Programme**' for SA's finest young talent.

Moto Trials SA has joined forces with The Hell Team and Gas Motos Australia in a 3 year deal to develop and nurture the rising young talent that SA has started to develop. And it won't stop when our riders turn 16 either, as this is also open to all riders under, and up to, the age of 21.

The 4 Coaching Clinics that ran in 2011 will now come under this banner, and whilst it may seem they will now take on a slight bias towards our under 21's, that will not be the case, as they will still be open to **all** of our riders in SA, who will be more than catered for during the 4 renamed '**JDP Training Camps**'.

The 2012 JDP Training Camps will run the same as 2011, with sign on from 9.00am, and riding from 10.00am until 4.00pm, with a lunch break, supplied by Moto Trials SA. It is hoped that most of our coaching staff will be present at most, if not all of the Clinics, and that overnight camping will once again be available. More information on each camp will be made available once the season is underway – look for details in the TROY Series programmes.

Perhaps the most exciting new initiative is the 3 day **Junior & Youth Spring Camp** that is being planned for the **October Long Weekend**, to be held at **Eden Valley** (the 2011 Australian Championship site) and the **Keyneton MCC Clubrooms** (Flaxman's Valley Road, Wilton). At the moment negotiations are taking place between Moto Trials SA, the **Office for Rec & Sport** and the **South Australian Sports Institute** as to what this Camp will contain, with coaches and lecturers being sought from all aspects of sports in Australia.

Coaches and/or lecturers that have already been, or will be, approached for this Camp include Australian Champions and Australian representatives **Kyle Middleton**, **Kristie McKinnon** and **Bev Anderson-Tranter**, as well as Paralympic Gold Medallist, **Tim Maloney OAM**, and Gas Gas dealer, **Paul Arnott**. There is also a chance that **Jordi Pascuet** may return to Australia in 2012, and we will do all we can to get him to SA for this!

Plans are also underway to include **level 1** and **level 2 Coaches Courses** to run concurrently with the Camp, meaning level 1 coaches that would like to start upgrading to level 2, or any new coaches, will also be catered for.

Look for all the details on this to be made available by the time of the Mountain Man Moto Trial in June. This camp, with all of the planned content will be a major development, not only for motorcycling, but for sport in general in South Australia, and it is certainly an exciting new direction for moto trials to be leading into!

MAJOR SA EVENT - PETER SPARKES SIDECAR TROPHY - JUNE 3 @ TONGKILLO

The 2012 Peter Sparkes Sidecar trophy, the 38th running of Australia's premier sidecar event, after the Australian Championships, will once again take place at Maurice Collins' iconic trials property at Tongkillo, the weekend after the World Championship round in Victoria.

The 2012 edition of the Peter Sparkes will once again be run again, as always, by the AJS Moto Trial Club of SA, and will feature all 3 grades run as separate classes for the first time in 2012, with B Grade & Classics to run alongside A Grade. At this stage the organisers are looking at an all day ride once again for sidecars, and a field of over 20 would be hoped for!
