

TROY Series SA - update with 1 round to go, September 12th at Mungereee!

RED - Looks like Jarrod Barwick will come out on top - but only if he rides and finishes the last round, otherwise Grant Stephen can upstage him!

YELLOW - The unbeaten 'Hoges' can clean sweep at the final round, especially as it is in his back yard, but interest will be in second - can Joel Cramond keep Mark Opie at bay, with only 2 points between them with a round to ride?

BLUE - The Class of the year so far with 4 different winners in 4 rounds, in a battle of youth verses experience! Youngsters Connor Hogan & Brad Hunter are locked on top and round 5 will be the decider, which may suit Connor as it is on his home turf, with the experienced PA & Scott Baxendale trying to keep rookie Dan McKenzie off of the podium!

WHITE - The Juniors have been a 2 horse race with Hugh Evans & Tyrin Wundenberg the only riders on Open Licences, with rookie Hugh a clear leader thanks to Tyrin missing a round. All the Junior B's have ridden well though and all deserve a big cheer!

BLACK & WHITE - The evergreen Joe Tarabini has this class locked away, being the only rider to ride all rounds, but the minor placings are still up for grabs with Pete Cunningham in 2nd. Three other riders in Doug Phillips, Greg Button & Tony Tildesley are all in with a podium chance, but they need to ride the last round to qualify!

PINK - Like Joe, Tyler Hogan has this class locked away, but a couple of Juniors in Heather Button and Jasmine Tarrant are in with a chance of finishing on the podium, but both need to ride the last round to qualify!

RED & WHITE - Alex Turner & Brad Hunter are in the box seat here with 4 wins from 4 starts, but will need to ride, and finish, round 5 to ensure the win as they can both be unseated by Duncan Greenhalgh (rider) and Dave Ramsey (passenger). Stuart Gerhardy is in a safe 3rd in the riders class, with Lachie Greenhalgh the only other passenger in with a chance, but will need to ride round 5 to qualify!
