Dear Competitor,

Hello and welcome to the 3rd round of the 2019 Eagle Trailers and Campers SA MX Championship. Please find the information required for the event. We thank you for supporting our club and the series.

This event is an OPEN meeting and is open to **Senior & Junior National Licence Holders and One Event National Licences Only**. Recreational licences are **ONLY VALID** for the 50cc Demonstration.

This event will be run as per the 2019 MoMS, the Supplementary Regulations and these Final Instructions.

THE ONUS IS ON YOU TO ensure that your licence is current, clear of any suspension, and of the correct endorsement.

## Venue information:

- The track is located on Denial Bay Road, Ceduna. The turn off is off of the Eyre Highway. The track is approximately 6-7kms from the turnoff and is on the right when heading from the Highway.
- Please use the 2<sup>nd</sup> entrance – Carpenter Road – labelled 'Pits' for entry to the venue.
- Camping is permitted at the venue – toilets are available but no showers. There are showers available at the BP Roadhouse.
- Please keep camping and pit areas clean. 10pm Curfew.
- BINS are provided – please use them accordingly.
- STRICTLY NO Alcohol in the pit area. Anyone camping at the venue must ensure that all alcohol is put away during the meeting.
- No fires are permitted during the meeting.
- Pit tents must be secured properly.
- No open-toed shoes.
- Pushbikes are to be put away during the meeting.
- Dogs are not allowed on the premises (exception of Human Aid dogs).
- Bikes are to be washed in the designated wash bay area only.
- No pillion passengers at any time.
- Helmets must be worn when a motorcycle is being ridden.
